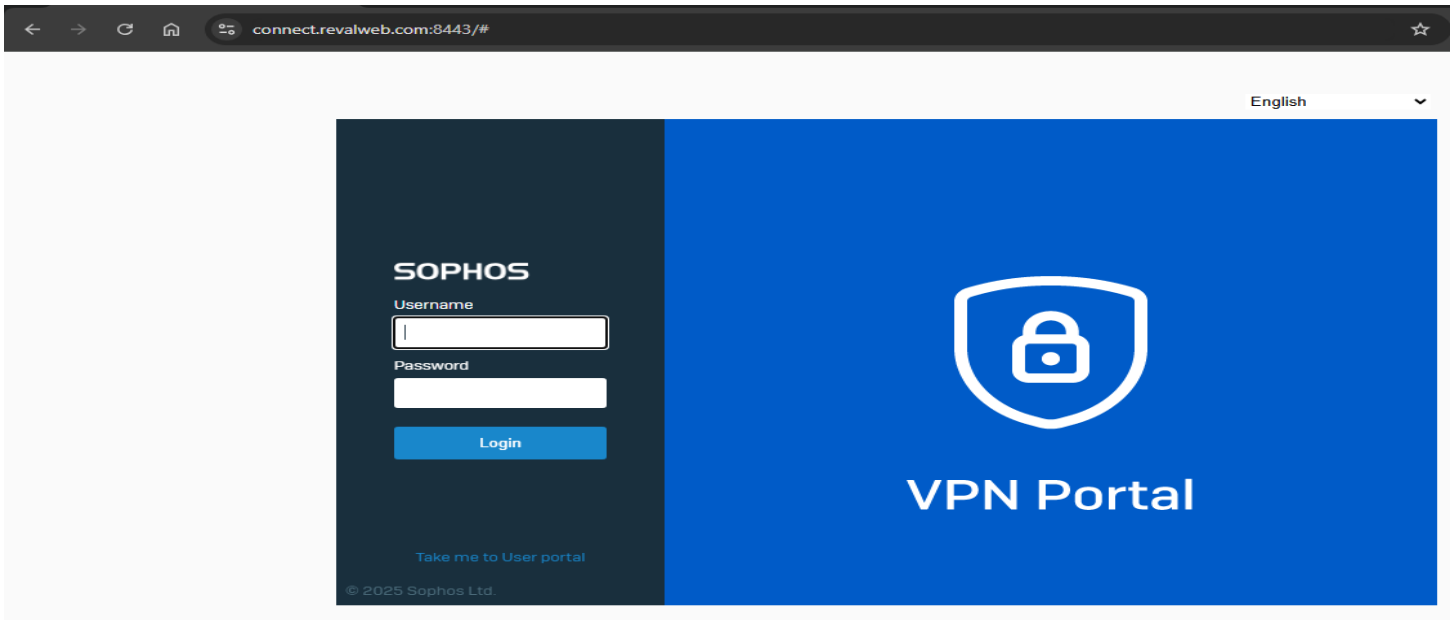




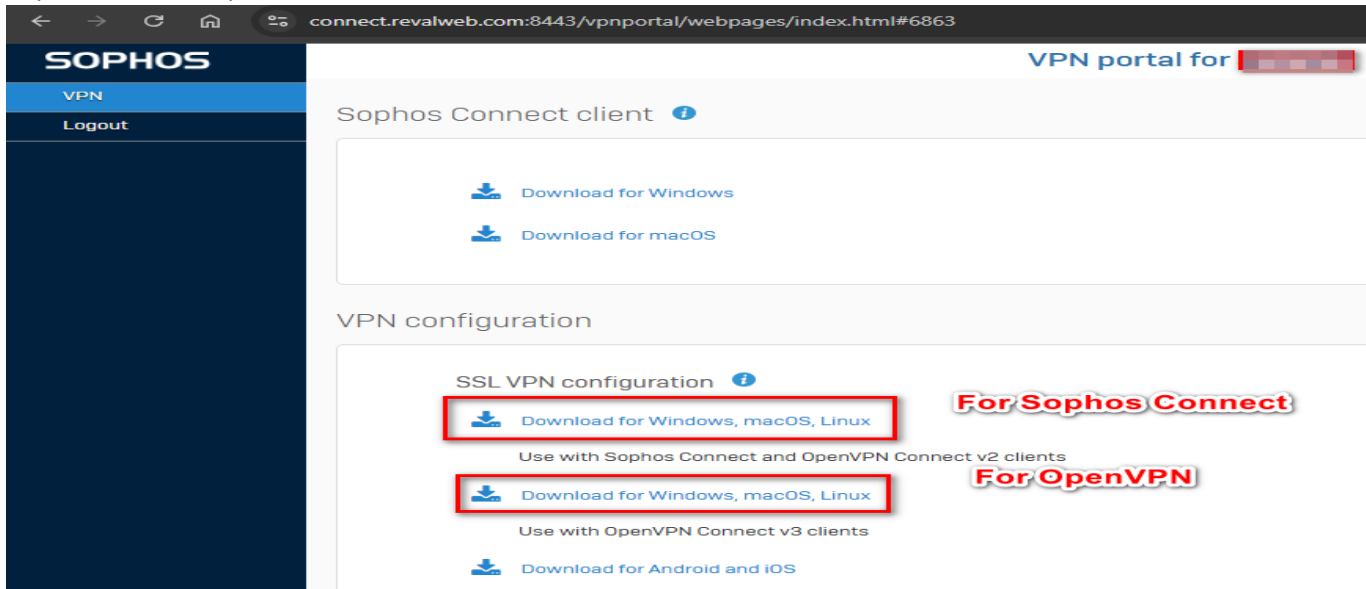
1. Configuration file download

- i) Open the VPN Portal and login using your VPN Credentials using any browser.

URL:- <https://connect.revalweb.com:8443>

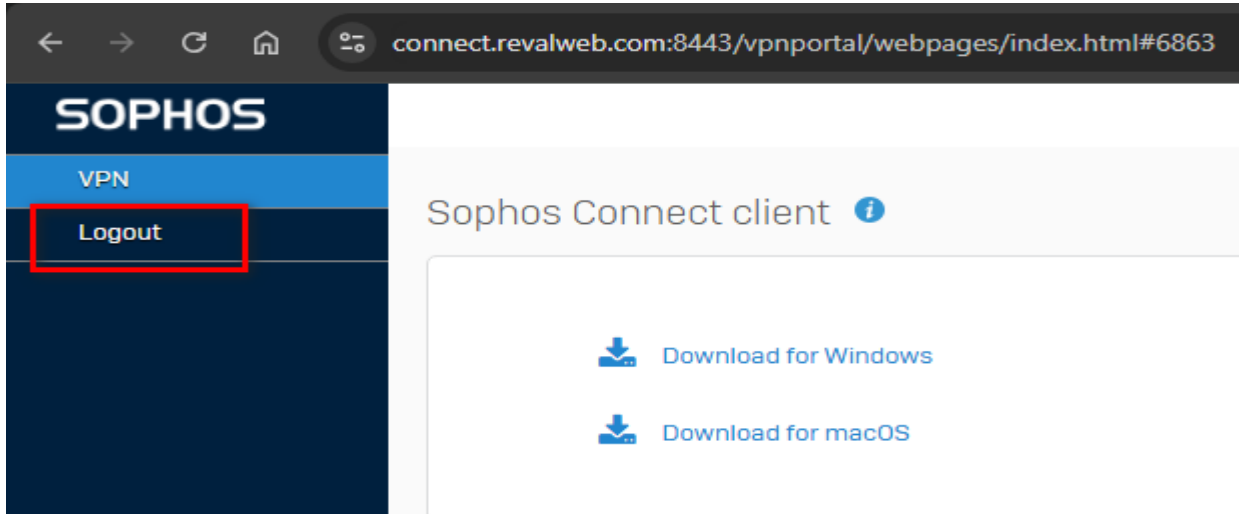


- ii) After successful login, download the configuration file as per the software installed in your machine i.e., Sophos Client or OpenVPN





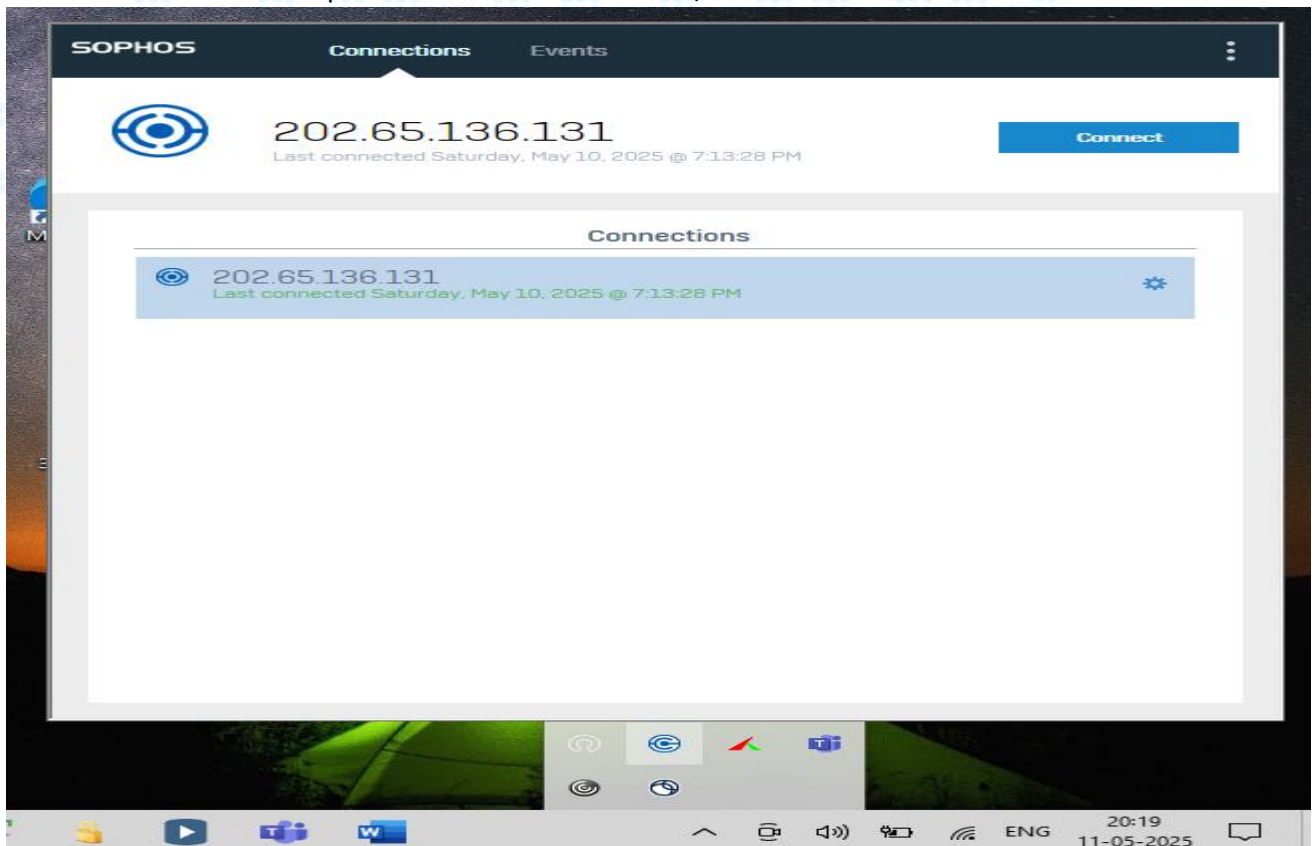
iii) After downloading the Configuration file, click on Logout from the VPN portal.



2. Updating Configuration file

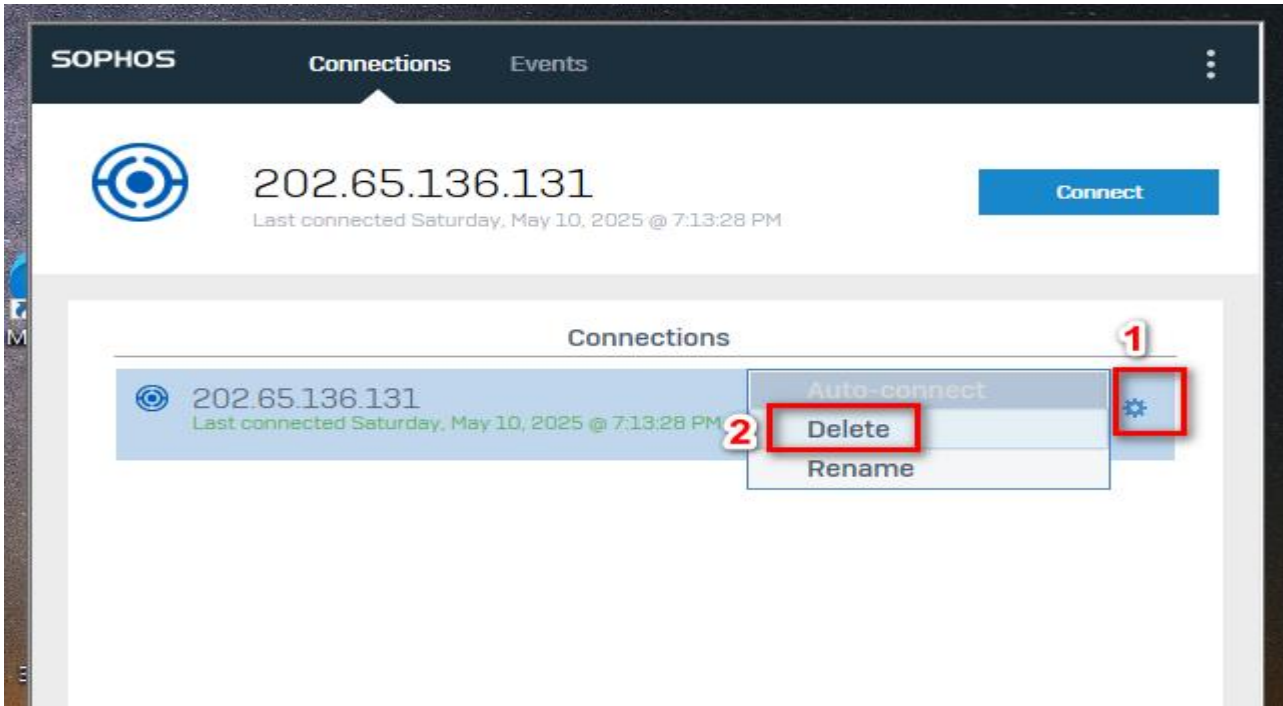
Now Open the VPN software you use to connect to Revalsys VPN.

- i) For Sophos Connect
 - a. Click on Sophos Connect from the taskbar/Show hidden icons

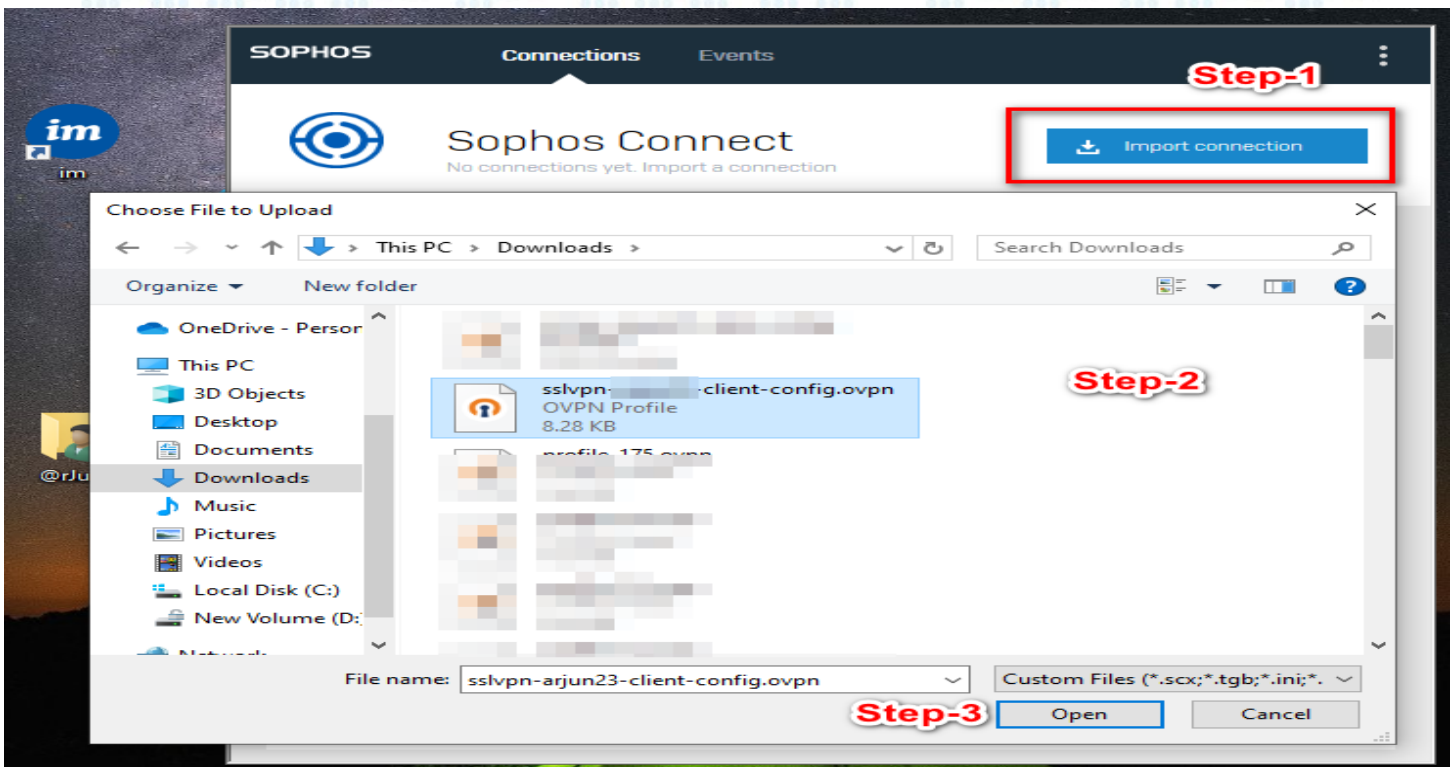




- b. Click on Edit connection for 202.65.136.131 or 183.82.2.220 profile and click on delete and select ok

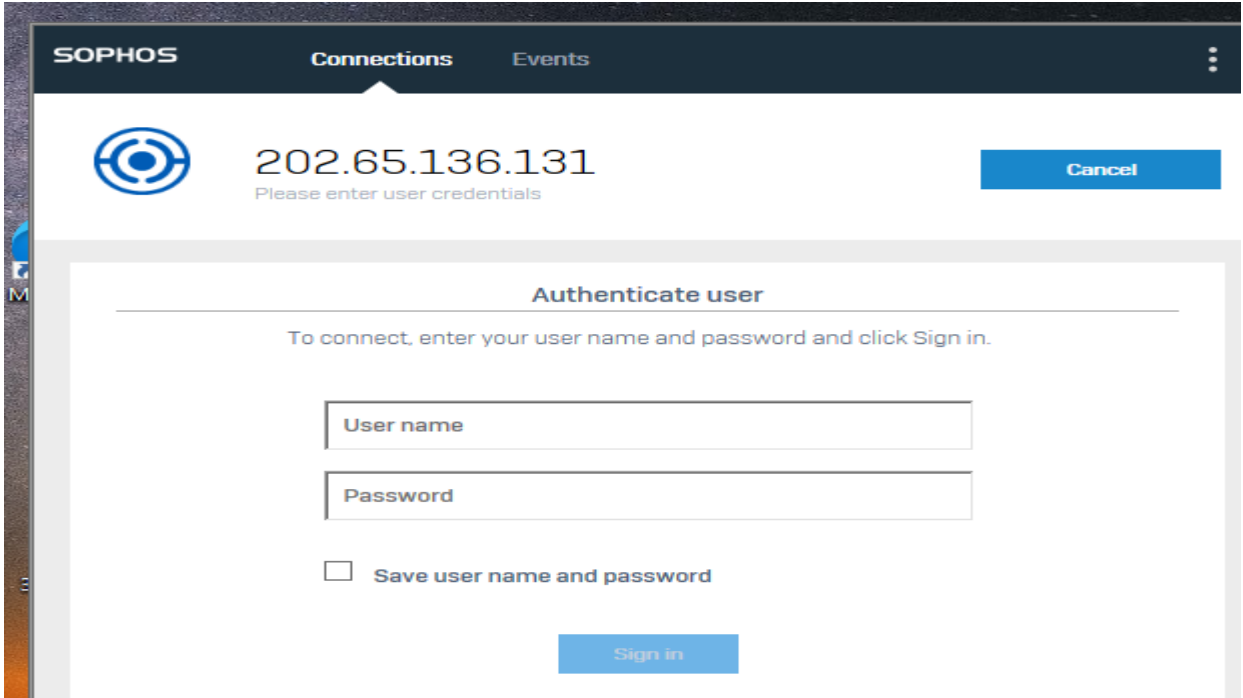


- c. Click on Import connection and select the downloaded file and click on Open.

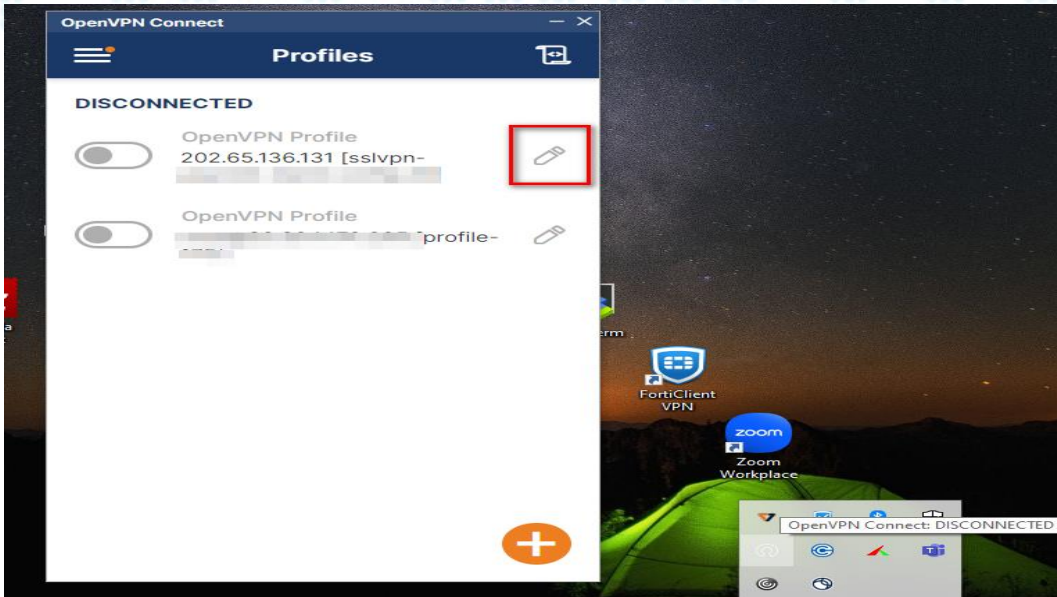




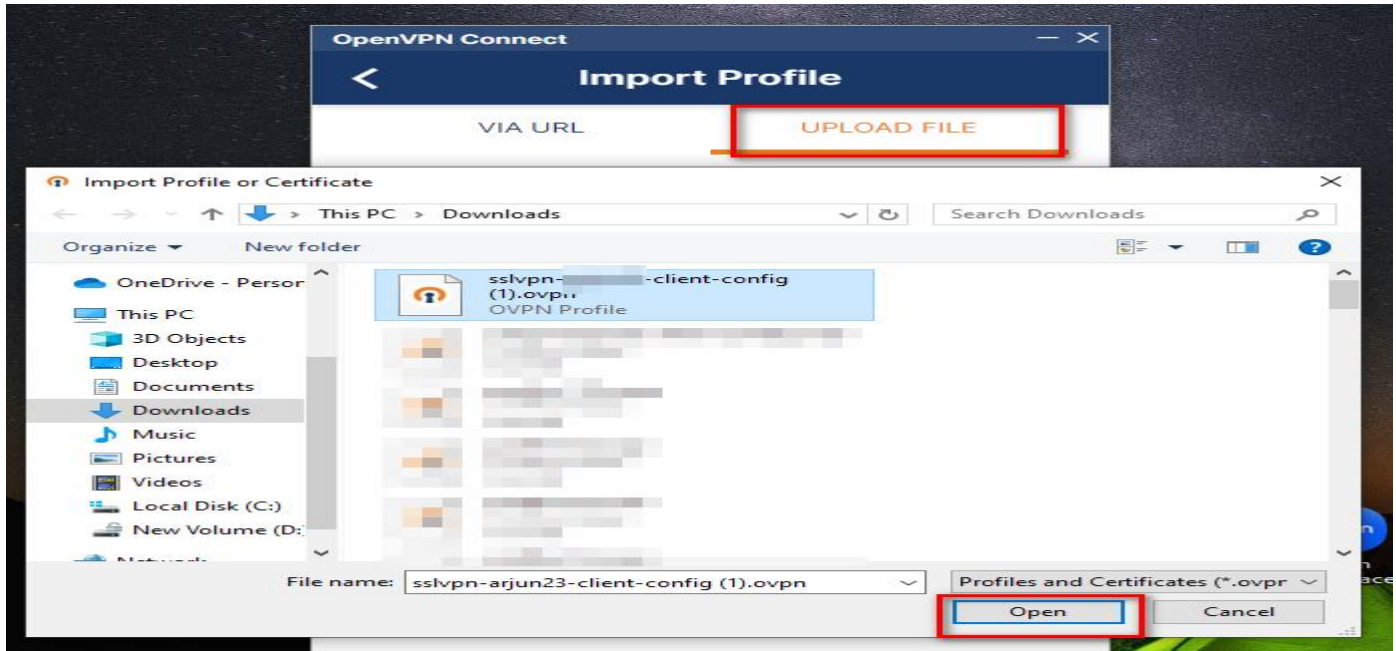

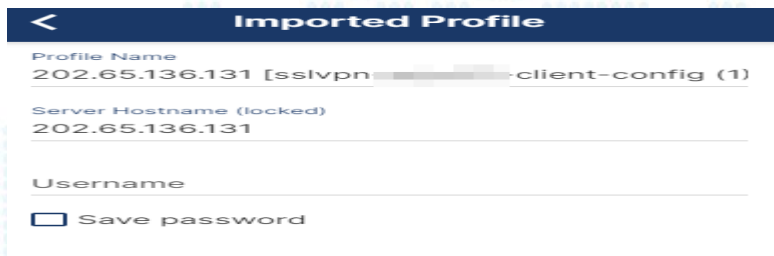
- ii) For Open VPN

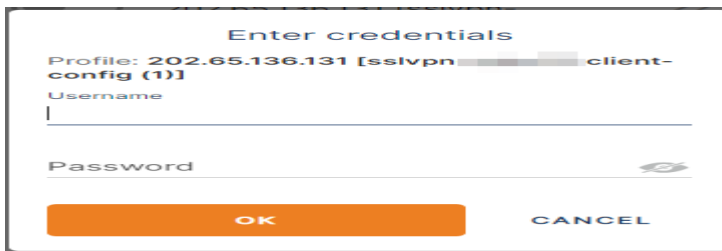
- b. Click on + icon and select Upload File and click on Browse and select the downloaded configuration file.
